

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING  
March 2, 2011

A special meeting of the Sherburn City Council and local townships was duly called to order by Mayor Robert Roesler at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 2, 2011 with members Robert Roesler, Jeff Ross, Brad Ringnell and Carroll Behne present. Absent, Kurt Olson. Also present, City Admin/EDA Dir Jamie Letzring, Deputy Clerk Irene Schlaphoff, and Bert Schwager, Karl Olson and Mike Lyon of the Sherburn Fire Department.

The purpose of this special meeting was to discuss placement of a bid for the purchase of a 2001 tanker from the City of Foley with representatives of Elm Creek, Fox Lake, Jay and Manyaska townships and to seek their input. Fire Chief Bert Schwager explained the need for replacement of the 1985 Chevy tanker presently in use, and the specifications of the 2001 tanker. Questions were answered regarding disposal of the old unit and future needs of the department.

City Administrator Jamie Letzring recapped a previous meeting with the townships at which funding equipment with township per section fees was discussed, and the set-aside amounts that are available at this time. Township officials were in favor of Fire Chief Bert Schwager placing an aggressive bid using the funds available.
